INHERENT RISK: Studying karate is an intense sports activity that involves some controlled, intentional physical contact with other participants. All sports activities entail risk of injury. Participants and teachers occasionally make mistakes, equipment sometimes fails, and unforeseen physical hazards or medical conditions may emerge. You risk injury by studying karate. By choosing to study karate at USA Karate Academy and by choosing to participate in events sponsored by Pacific Northwest AAU Karate District or the Japan International Karate-Do Federation (collectively, "USA-AAU-JIKF"), you are agreeing to accept the risk of such injuries.

WAIVER AND RELEASE: USA-AAU-JIKF Karate has taken all steps it deems reasonable and necessary to prevent the usual causes of injury. Nevertheless, participants may be injured by themselves or paid staff or volunteers of USA-AAU-JIKF or by other participants. By participating in the school and events organized by USA-AAU-JIKF, you agree to waive all causes of action against USA-AAU-JIKF and release all claims of damage with respect to any injury attributable to the ordinary or gross negligence of USA-AAU-JIKF. You are not agreeing to waive causes of action related to the intentional acts of USA-AAU-JIKF or participants.

CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT: If you are injured while participating in an event related to USA-AAU-JIKF, you and your parent (or guardian) agrees that USA-AAU-JIKF may administer first aid to you. Minors are unable to make medical decisions. If you are unable to make medical decisions and your parent or guardian is unavailable to make medical decisions on your behalf, then you and your parent (or guardian) consent to USA-AAU-JIKF transporting you or causing you to be transported to a nearby hospital or other medical facility, where you agree to follow the medical advice and treatment prescribed by the medical staff of that facility, until such time as you or your parent (or guardian) can make decisions on your behalf.

USA KARATE MEMBERSHIP POLICIES

Enrollment policies

- Student represents that he/she is physically fit to receive and participate in the prescribed course of instruction.
- Student understands that monthly tuition payments must be submitted on the agreed date regardless of attendance.
- Student understands that a late charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) will be assessed for payments three (3) business days past due.
- Student understands that there is a thirty dollar (\$30.00) fee for checks returned by the bank.
- Student understands that there are no refunds or credits given for missed classes.
- Student understands that should they wish to discontinue their karate school enrollment, that they must notify the school in writing 15 days in advance.
- Students may choose to pay their tuition by automatic debit/credit, or in-house billing. Those who use auto pay through debit or credit card will receive a reduced rate. (See Fee Schedule)
- Students understand that the yearly membership fee is \$85.00. Sixteen dollars (\$16.00) of each is designated for each youth member's individual membership in the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU). Adults must register themselves with AAU online.

ALL participants of USA Karate Academy must submit their membership fees each year, and immediately upon enrollment.

- The student will faithfully comply with all the rules and regulations of the school and traditions of the martial arts.

THE SCHOOL WILL:

- Provide the student with competent instruction in the martial arts.
- Ensure that each class is supervised by qualified personnel trained in the procedures and traditions of the martial arts.
- Allow students to request one-on-one help from time to time as the staff schedule permits.
- Provide the student with a welcome packet and promotion book to learning upon the student's enrollment.
- Allow students to make up missed classes in a timely manner.
- Notify students of any class or schedule changes as soon as possible.
